

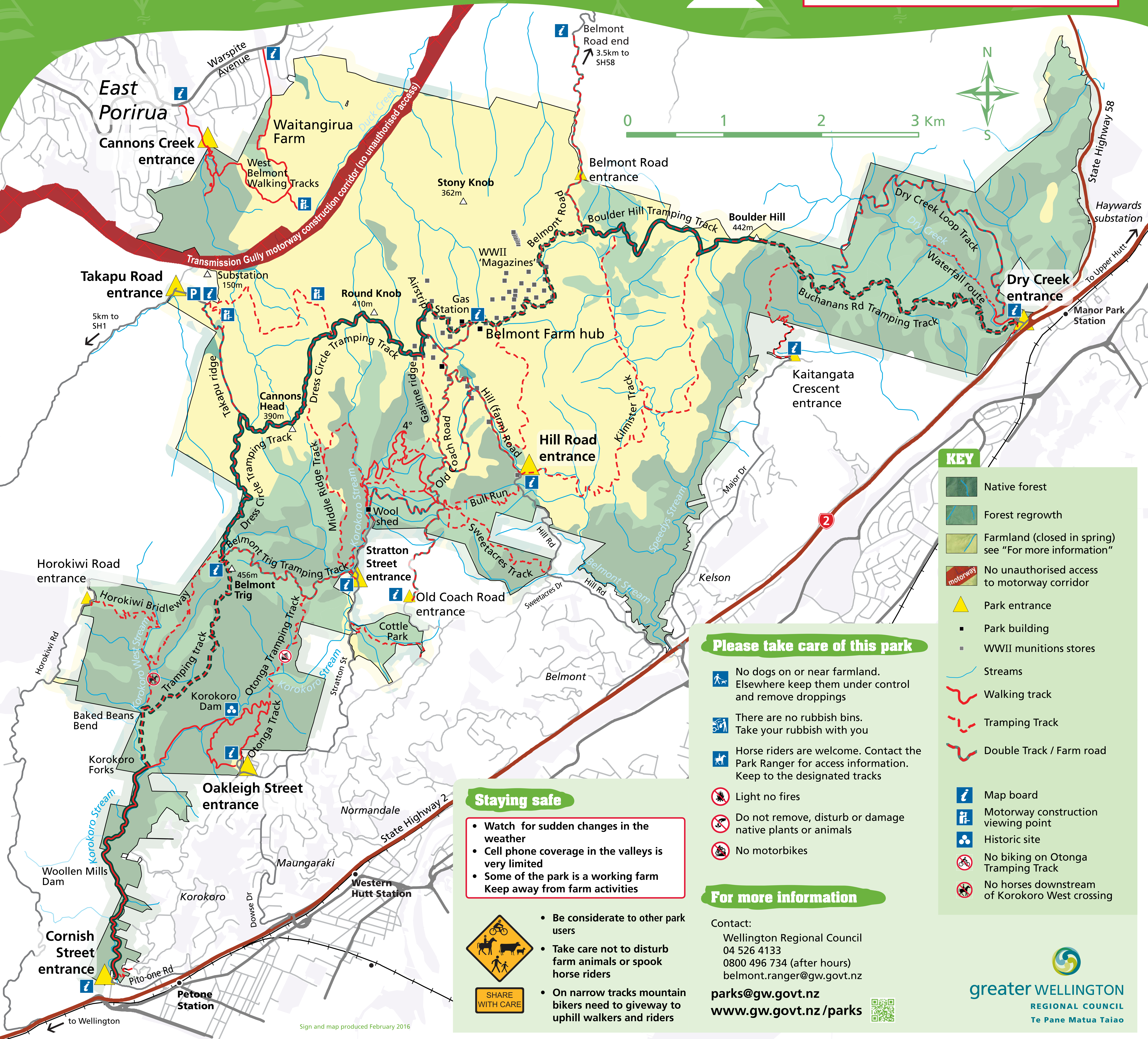

- No motorbikes

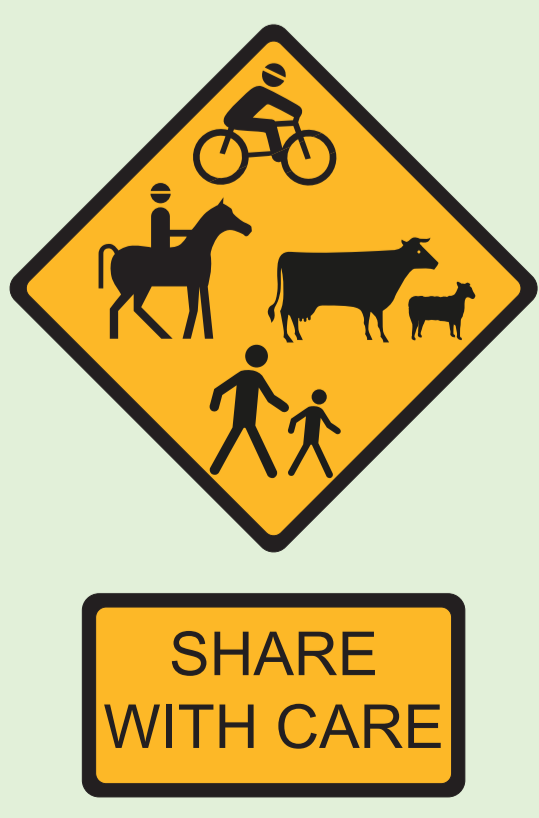

Staying safe

- Watch for sudden changes in the weather
- Cell phone coverage in the valleys is very limited
- Some of the park is a working farm. Keep away from farm activities

- Be considerate to other park users
- Take care not to disturb farm animals or spook horse riders
- On narrow tracks mountain bikers need to give way to uphill walkers and riders
